Before Cutting

- **Mark opening to be cut clearly.**
- **Check work piece for nails, screws or other obstructions.**
- **Check to make sure that cutting path does not go through any electrical wiring or plumbing.**
- **Make sure work piece is secure and will not come loose after cutting has begun.**
- **Check to make sure the proper bit is equipped for the material you are cutting. If you are unsure ask a supervisor.**
- **Make sure the power switch is in the off position before connecting the tool to a power source.**
- **Stand so you have sure footing and proper balance.**

While Cutting

- **Never start the tool with the bit already in the material.**
- **Allow bit to reach its maximum speed before cutting.**
- **Do not force bit through the material you are cutting, cut slowly so the bit does not bind.**
- **If the bit does bind or get stuck in the material turn the tool off. Once all parts have stopped moving unplug the tool and carefully remove it from the material.**

After Cutting

- **Do not put your hands near the bit or collet unless all parts have stopped moving and the tool has had time to cool down (bits and collet may become hot during use).**
- **Do not set the tool down until all parts have stopped moving.**
- **Make sure work area is clear of debris.**
